Table shows that Number of questionnaires distributed and received back from Education students. There are 100 Questionnaire are distributed and 77(77%) are received back from the students.




Fig. 1 Number of questionnaires distributed and received back




Fig.2 Gender wise response received




Fig.3 Age wise response received




Fig.4 often visit to the library




Fig.5 Time spent in college library




Fig.6 purpose of visit to the library




Fig.7 Library collection for reading




Fig.8 opinion on library Services




Fig.9 opinion on library Physical facilities
